IMMIGRATION DOCUMENT CHECKLIST - CUSTOMER COPY

GOVERNMENT FILING FEE(S)

Online filing: **\$1,335**

Paper filing: **\$1,385**

Certain adopted-child filings: **\$0** when the USCIS fee-exempt criteria are met.

Current/former U.S. armed forces member filing for self: **\$0**; certain applicants may qualify for a fee waiver.

Fees shown are government fees, not Berhan Solutions service fees. Verify the current government fee before filing because fees and exemptions can change.

GENERAL ITEMS

- Government-issued photo ID
- Passport biographic page, if applicable
- All prior USCIS notices, A-number, USCIS Online Account Number, and immigration documents, if applicable
- Certified English translations for required foreign-language documents
- Legal name-change documents if names differ among records

APPLICANT / CHILD

- Birth certificate showing the child's/applicant's parents
- Permanent Resident Card, if applicable
- Current and prior passports, including U.S. passport if already issued
- Two passport-style photographs if required by the current filing instructions
- Evidence of lawful permanent resident status/admission, if citizenship claim is based on INA 320
- Any prior Certificate of Citizenship, Consular Report of Birth Abroad, or citizenship-related USCIS/Department of State records

U.S. CITIZEN PARENT

- Parent's U.S. birth certificate, U.S. passport, Certificate of Naturalization, Certificate of Citizenship, or Consular Report of Birth Abroad, as applicable
- Parent's marriage certificate and documents terminating prior marriages, if relevant
- Evidence establishing the legal parent-child relationship where required

CUSTODY / RESIDENCE / RELATIONSHIP - AS APPLICABLE

- Evidence the child resided in the United States in the legal and physical custody of the U.S. citizen parent when required
- Custody order, divorce decree, guardianship documents, or other custody evidence if applicable
- Adoption decree and evidence relevant to the adoption requirements if adopted
- For a child born out of wedlock, legitimation, acknowledgment, custody, or other relationship evidence required for the citizenship claim, as applicable
- Legal name-change documents for applicant or parent if names differ

IMPORTANT

- Form N-600 is for a person claiming U.S. citizenship acquired or derived through a parent; it is not an application to become a citizen through the regular naturalization process.
- Bring all documents showing when each citizenship requirement was satisfied, especially documents relating to the child's age, LPR status, residence, and legal/physical custody.
